

LIVING WATER is pleased to partner with Everett's HANDS FOR PEACEMAKING FOUNDATION on a water project (community spring development) for Vuelta Grande, Guatemala.

In its 25th year of promoting economic development, improving health conditions, and strengthening access to education, the Hands for Peacemaking Foundation works in the remote, mountainous regions of rural Guatemala where a predominately Mayan population resides. Many villages have neither electricity nor a safe water supply. Food is scarce.

In Vuelta Grande, thanks to your continuing generosity, *Living Water* will provide \$10,000 to assist the community to purchase a nearby property with a natural spring together with the water rights. A cement cap and perimeter fencing will protect the water from contamination, so that healthy & safe drinking water will be readily available for the village. Neighboring villages may access the well (spring) as well. Hands for Peacemaking has knowledgeable people in place in Vuelta Grande with the expertise and equipment to complete this project in a fairly short time.
