As we celebrate Trinity's 75th anniversary, we gratefully look back to the women who have paved the way for us to move forward. You probably remember the early groups known as "Ladies Aid." The book, *Lutheran Church Basement Women: Lutefisk, Lefse, Lunch & Jell-o*, is a historical and hilarious account of women in the church. Our current women's organization, WELCA (Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America), began in 1987 in Milwaukee. 2017 is a year of anniversaries: 75 for Trinity; 500 for the Reformation; and 30 for WELCA.

TLCW is structured around the four components of our worship services: Gathering, Word, Meal and Sending.

We **Gather** together regularly to renew existing friendships, to welcome new friends and to share our stories. The magazine of WELCA is "Gather." This publication contains writings relative to the monthly emphasis, as determined by the subject of the Bible study.

The **Word** is central to TLCW. All are invited to join a circle which meets monthly to study the lesson from "Gather."

Looking back, we remember the hospitality and love expressed through the cooking and baking of the women in our churches. The **Meal** is part of our gathering times. Through potlucks & lunches, Thankoffering worship, Holly Berry Brunch, Spring Salad Luncheon and circle meetings, we welcome all to our table(s).

We are servants. Through our offerings, quilts, prayer shawls, prayers and in-kind gifts, we **Send** ourselves and our love to a hurting world. A new project, in association with Holly House, will be the collecting of pajama bottoms

(flannel and polar fleece) for youth, 8 years to 18 years old. These will be given, at Christmas, to low-income children in fifteen schools in the Edmonds School District.

In the thirty years since women gathered together to form WELCA, much has happened. "Together we've accomplished more than we ever could have individually. Our foremothers helped to make women's ordination a reality. We have led the church in our focus on racial justice, on those living in poverty, and on ending human trafficking. We were the first in the churchwide organization to have a podcast (2006) and a smart phone app (2011). Women of all ages serve side-by-side."

In the future, we hope to continue to be a catalyst in the church's moving forward, locally and globally. Linda Post Bushkofsky, executive director of WELCA, has expressed several hopes for the future... "I hope we involve more participants because women need the support of other women in their faith journeys. I hope we avoid the scarcity mentality and live into abundance. I hope we never lose our hands-on-work from quilting to praying together. I hope we begin organizing ourselves in new and different ways. I hope we throw away seven deadly words: 'But we've never done it that way.'"

We look forward to getting to know you, "remembering that we are all a part of God's work to make all things new."

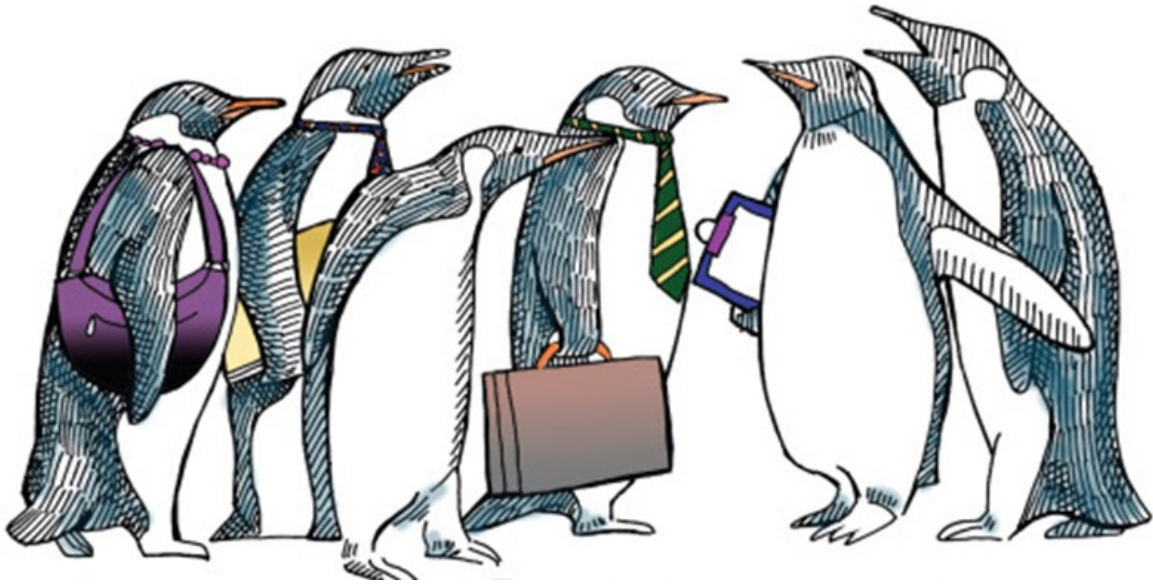

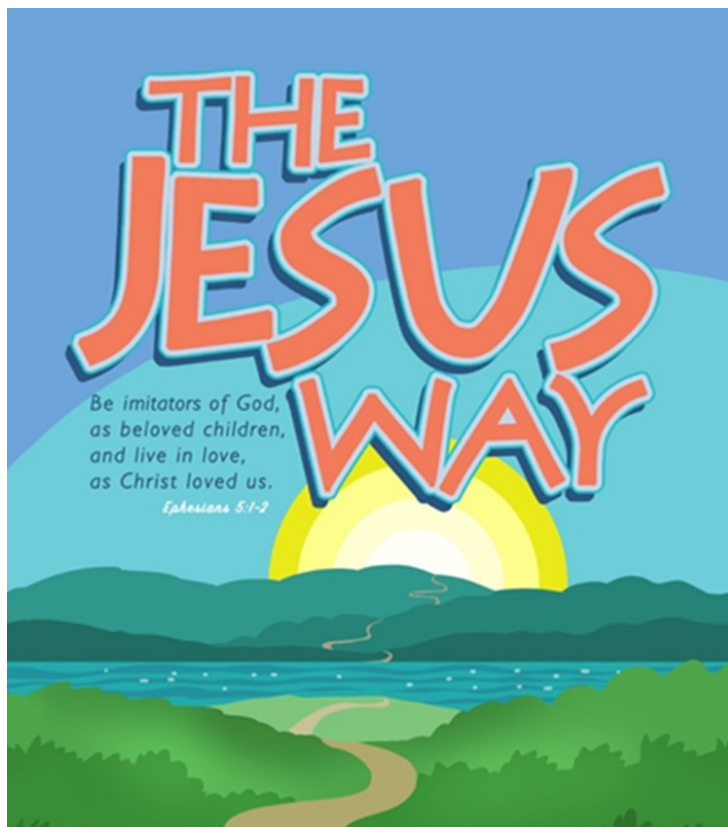
75th Anniversary Picture Directory
