Mystery Trip

The big summer trip for high school students this year is the Mystery Trip. The team of 13 students and 3 adults will be spending 10 days traveling around the Pacific Northwest doing service projects and enjoying some exciting adventures as they learn some new spiritual disciplines, including living in close community for 10 days in two vans.

Why a mystery trip? Each day the students will have a riddle to solve if they want to know what they will be doing or where they will be going. But it is also about discovering what each day will bring and working as a group on each adventure or service project, or just being a group.

It is also about allowing space for mystery in your life: not having everything planned, and instead allowing for the unexpected. The mystery is also about living in the moment. In any good mystery you live in the space that is right now. On this trip it is about living into what you are doing each part of each day. If it is down time, you enjoy it; if it is engaging in some fun, going for it; if it is in serving, doing your best to serve. Mystery means not worrying about what is next.

Lastly, God is mystery. Often people of faith leave the faith out of their experience. They want answers. They want specific directions. But faith is about trusting that God is there in all we do. This trip is about letting God reveal to us His love each day. Students will be challenged to experience some spiritual disciplines along the way.

The Mystery Trip Team leaves Friday, July 28 and returns August 6. We would ask for you to pray for us daily for safe journey and times.
